HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1397, L.D. 1981, Bill, "An Act to Make Changes in the Workers' Compensation System"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end of Part D the following:

Sec. D-27. Applications. Except as otherwise provided, this Act applies only to injuries occurring on or after the effective date of this Act.

Sec. D-28. Effective date. The following sections take effect January 1, 1992:

1. Those sections in Part A enacting the Maine Revised Statutes:

- Title 24-A, section 2362-A;
- Title 24-A, section 2362-B;
- Title 24-A, section 2365-A;
- Title 24-A, section 2366, subsection 5, paragraph C; and
- Title 24-A, section 2366, subsection 7-A;

2. Those sections in Part A amending:

- Title 24-A, section 2364, subsection 4, paragraph A;
- Title 24-A, section 2366, subsection 2, paragraph B;
- Title 24-A, section 2366, subsection 3, paragraphs A and B; and
- Title 39, section 72; and

3. Those sections in Part C enacting:

Title 24-A, section 2364, subsection 4, paragraph C-1; and
4 Title 24-A, section 2366, subsection 11.'

10 This amendment clarifies that the provisions of this Act
apply only to injuries occurring on or after the effective date
of this Act, unless otherwise provided.

14 This amendment also delays the effective date for the
provisions addressing interest on workers' compensation awards
and the provisions affecting workers' compensation rates and the
16 residual market.
