HOUSE AMENDMENT "CC" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

**Sec. OO-1. State stipends rescinded.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 7065 or any other provision of law, State stipends granted to any persons employed by the State of Maine, except employees of the Augusta Mental Health Institute, the Bangor Mental Health Institute and the Pineland Center are rescinded effective at the beginning of the pay period closest to January 1, 1992.

**Sec. OO-2. Calculation and transfer.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer is authorized to calculate the amount of savings realized by the application of section 3 of this Part that applies against each account. The State Budget Officer shall cause the calculated amount to be transferred from each account and forward a report on the distribution to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

**Sec. OO-3. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
