HOUSE AMENDMENT 'EE' to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. The Joint Standing Committee on Taxation shall report out a bill by January 31, 1992 that amends or removes exemptions in the tax expenditure budget in an amount not less than \$7,110,244.

Sec. OO-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

All Other \$7,110,244

Provides for the appropriation of funds by amending or removing exemptions from the tax expenditure budget.'

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.
