HOUSE AMENDMENT "FFF" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part S by striking out all of sections 5, 18, 19, 30, 33, 34 and 35.

Further amend the bill in Part S by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

Sec. OO-1. 20-A MRSA §13016, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

5. Current certificates extended. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the expiration date of any teacher certificate for an active teacher that is valid on December 18, 1991 is extended for 5 years.

Sec. OO-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "FFF" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.

#### FISCAL NOTE

This amendment makes General Fund deappropriations to the Department of Education in the amount of \$90,630 in fiscal year 1991-92 and appropriates that same amount to restore the Maine Committee on Aging, the Maine Commission on Mental Health, the Maine Commission for Women and a position at the Maine Youth Center, resulting in no net fiscal impact to the bill.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This part extends the expiration date of current valid teacher certificates by 5 years. During that time the Department of Education will be relieved of the responsibility to process recertification applications and to enforce recertification requirements for teachers. The savings resulting from the reduction in the department's workload are used to restore services within the Committee on Aging, the Commission on Mental Health, the Commission for Women and the Maine Youth Center.
