HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. Blaine House closure. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Blaine House must be closed between January 1, 1992 and June 30, 1992.

Sec. OO-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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FISCAL NOTE

8 This amendment proposes to close the Blaine House effective
January 1, 1992 and will result in a General Fund deappropriation
10 of \$51,812 in fiscal year 1991-92 by eliminating 5.5 full-time
equivalency positions and general operating expenses, thereby
12 increasing the total General Fund savings realized by the bill.

18 This amendment provides for the deappropriation of funds
