HOUSE AMENDMENT "HHH" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides for the appropriation of funds that support the Maine Technical College system operation to offset reduction in Part A.

4 **Sec. PP-1. Calculation and transfer.** Notwithstanding the Maine
 6 Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer
 shall calculate the amount in section 3 of this Part that applies
 8 against each General Fund account for all departments and
 agencies based on the total appropriations to those accounts,
 10 except for the following accounts: General Purpose Aid to Local
 Schools; Education in the Unorganized Territory; Debt Service -
 12 Treasury; Teacher Retirement; Aid to Families with Dependent
 Children; Aid to Families with Dependent Children - Foster Care;
 14 General Assistance; Maine Health Program; Intermediate Care -
 Payments to Providers; Medical Care - Payments to Providers;
 Bureau of Rehabilitation; and Bureau of Rehabilitation -
 16 Vocational Rehabilitation. The State Budget Officer shall cause
 the calculated amount to be transferred from each account.

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Sec. PP-2. Program or service eliminations. In implementing
 20 sections 1 and 3 of this Part, the heads of all departments and
 agencies in State Government, along with the State Budget
 22 Officer, shall take all necessary precautions to ensure that no
 program or service otherwise authorized by the Legislature is
 24 eliminated in fiscal year 1991-92 as a result of this Part.

26 **Sec. PP-3.. Appropriation.** The following funds are
 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of
 28 this Act.

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40 Provides for the deappropriation of funds by
 an across-the-board reduction of
 42 approximately 0.3% effective the last 6
 months in fiscal year 1991-92 except for the

 the 1% deappropriation authorized by Public
 46 Law 1991, chapter 591, Pt. QQQ.

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16 This amendment provides additional resources to the Maine
Technological Colleges by cutting state agencies across-the-board
18 by 0.3% which excludes General Purpose Aid, teacher retirement,
Aid to Families with Dependent Children and other special
20 programs. It is the intent of this amendment to provide more
jobs for Maine people.
