HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in that Part designated "PART DD" in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph E (page 182, lines 1 to 7 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'E. Notwithstanding this subsection and any other provision of law, for school years 1991-92 and 1992-93, school administrative units shall reduce the number of days for the maintenance of all schools by 5 days a year.'

Further amend the bill in Part II in section 2 in the 12th line (page 191, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2%" and inserting in its place the following: '4%'

Further amend the bill in Part II by striking out all of sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. II-4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

12 This amendment has no net General Fund impact.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This amendment provides for a mandatory 5 furlough days for
18 all school units in the State and eliminates the Percent for Art
20 program to reduce costs to local school units.

22 This amendment also deappropriates General Fund savings from:

24 (1) \$1.5 million additional reduction in state funding to
the Maine Maritime Academy;

26 (2) A reduction of \$500,000 in state funding to the
University of Maine System, which is intended to be offset
28 through an additional increase in the tuition for students
at the School of Law; and

30 (3) The elimination of the canine operations at the Maine
32 State Prison at Thomaston.

34 These General Fund savings in fiscal year 1991-92 are used
to offset the reductions to the General Purpose Aid for Local
36 Schools and State Municipal Revenue Sharing.
