HOUSE AMENDMENT "JJJ" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part A in section A-1 under that part designated "DEFENSE AND VETERANS' SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of that part relating to "Commission on Vietnam and Atomic Veterans" (page 18, lines 8 to 22 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Commission on Vietnam and Atomic Veterans

Positions - Legislative Count	(-1.0)
Personal Services	(5,827)
All Other	(8,324)
TOTAL	<u>(14,151)</u>

Provides for the deappropriation of funds through the elimination of one Clerk Stenographer II position and funds for commission expenses. The Veterans Counselor position will assume responsibility for both Vietnam and Atomic Veterans as well as other veterans.
