The Veterans Counselor 38 position will assume responsibility for both Vietnam and Atomic Veterans as well as other 40 veterans. 42 Maine Emergency Management Agency (24,879)All Other 44 Provides for the deappropriation of funds 46 from the reduction of general operating 48 expenses.'
