HOUSE AMENDMENT *LLL* to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. Calculation and transfer. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer shall calculate the amount in section 3 of this Part that applies against each General Fund account for all departments and agencies based on the total appropriations to those accounts, except for the following accounts: General Purpose Aid for Local Schools; Education in the Unorganized Territory; Debt Service - Treasury; Teacher Retirement; Aid to Families with Dependent Children; Aid to Families with Dependent Children - Foster Care; General Assistance; Maine Health Program, Intermediate Care - Payments to Providers; Medical Care - Payments to Providers; Bureau of Rehabilitation; and Bureau of Rehabilitation - Vocational Rehabilitation. The State Budget Officer shall cause the calculated amount to be transferred from each account.

Sec. OO-2. Program or service eliminations. In implementing sections 1 and 3 of this Part, the heads of all departments and agencies in State Government, along with the State Budget Officer, shall take all necessary precautions to ensure that no program or service otherwise authorized by the Legislature is eliminated in fiscal year 1991-92 as a result of this Part.

Sec. OO-3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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Provides for the deappropriation of funds by an across-the-board reduction of approximately 1.75%, effective for the last 6 months in fiscal year 1991-92 except for the General Fund accounts listed in section 1 of this Part. This reduction is in addition to the 1% deappropriation authorized by Public Law 1991, chapter 591, Part QQQ.

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TREASURER OF STATE, OFFICE OF

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State-Municipal Revenue Sharing

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All Other

\$6,100,000

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Provides for an appropriation of funds to offset the reductions in Part HH. These funds are to be distributed to municipalities on a monthly basis from January 1992 to June 1992 in accordance with the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5681, subsection 4.

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Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.

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FISCAL NOTE

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This amendment deappropriates (\$6,100,000) from the General Fund in fiscal year 1991-92 by adding an approximate 1.75% across-the-board reduction to most General Fund accounts. This same amount is then appropriated to State-Municipal Revenue Sharing. Therefore, this amendment will have no net effect on the total General Fund savings realized by the bill.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment increases funding to State-Municipal Revenue
Sharing by \$6,100,000 and offsets that increase by
6 across-the-board cuts to most General Fund accounts of 1.75%.
