HOUSE AMENDMENT "L" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part N in section N-1 in that part designated "\$193." by striking out the following: "Sagadahee County, -Bath;" (page 147, line 37 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Sagadahoc County, Bath;'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
