HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides for the deappropriation of funds from the termination of certain community contracts.

Department of Corrections in fiscal year 1991-92 and provides
40 General Fund appropriations to General Purpose Aid for Local
Schools of \$96,169 and to State Municipal Revenue Sharing of
42 \$96,170, thereby resulting in no net fiscal impact to the bill.

6 Correctional Center and the Maine State Prison will also be
terminated. The savings from these contracts are applied to
