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FISCAL NOTE

This amendment proposes to terminate several contracts and 38 will result in a General Fund deappropriation of \$192,339 to the Department of Corrections in fiscal year 1991-92 and provides 40 General Fund appropriations to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools of \$96,169 and to State Municipal Revenue Sharing of 42 \$96,170, thereby resulting in no net fiscal impact to the bill.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides for the termination of contracts 48 with the following agencies: Cathance Psychological Services, Community Schools, Inc., DHRS - The Christopher Home, Kennebec

Valley Regional Health Agency (CMPRC-Alcohol), Merrymeeting Farm, New Beginnings, Rumford Group Home, York County Alcoholism 2 Shelter and YWCA of Portland (shelter). Contracts with private 4 practioners for substance abuse services provided at the Maine Correctional Center and the Maine State Prison will also be terminated. The savings from these contracts are applied to offset cuts to General Purpose Aid to Education and Local Revenue Sharing.
