HOUSE AMENDMENT "N" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides for the deappropriation of funds resulting from the transfer of certain functions of the Bureau of Human Resources to individual state agencies, including the elimination of the following positions: 2 intermittent Clerk II positions without head count, one Clerk II position, one Clerk III position, one Word Processing Operator position, 2 Clerk Typist III positions, one Administrative Secretary position, one Director of Planning and Policy position, one Microfilm Clerk position, one State Affirmative Action Coordinator position, one Human Resources Automation Coordinator

2 position, 3 Merit System Coordinator
3 positions, 3 Senior Personnel Analyst

6 Sec. OO-3. Transfer of functions from Bureau of Human
8 Resources. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,
10 chapter 372, subchapter I, article I, or any other provision of
12 law, the Bureau of Human Resources is authorized to begin
14 transferring its duties and its functions to individual state
16 agencies. Preliminary steps toward the complete transfer of the
18 bureau's functions and duties may begin on the effective date of
this Part and must include the adoption of a new uniform hiring
policy, as required by federal law. A complete plan must be
submitted to the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature
recommending changes to certain provisions of the law necessary
to implement this transfer. The transfer of duties must be
complete by July 1, 1993.'

20 Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read
consecutively.

24 FISCAL NOTE

26 This amendment transfers some functions of the Bureau of
28 Human Resources to individual state agencies and results in a
30 General Fund deappropriation of \$316,027 to that bureau in fiscal
32 year 1991-92. The bill additionally appropriates \$158,013 to
General Purpose Aid for Local Schools in fiscal year 1991-92 and
\$158,014 to municipal revenue sharing in fiscal year 1991-92
resulting in no net fiscal impact to the bill.

34 STATEMENT OF FACT

36 This amendment deappropriates \$316,027 from the Bureau of
38 Human Resources and appropriates 1/2 of that amount to the
40 Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local Schools
42 and 1/2 of that amount to the Office of Treasurer of State, State
Municipal Revenue Sharing. The amendment authorizes the bureau
to begin transferring its duties and functions to individual
state agencies. This transfer must be complete by July 1, 1993.
