HOUSE AMENDMENT "OO" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part N in section 1 in the first line (page 146, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Sec. N-1."

Further amend the bill in Part N by striking out all of sections 2 and 3.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Restores funds deappropriated in Part A.'

This amendment restores funding for indigent defense and removes the provisions from the bill that would have changed the criteria for indigent defense appointment and eliminated mandatory jail terms for certain first offenses.
