HOUSE AMENDMENT "R" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

Provides for an appropriation of funds to offset the reduction of the foundation and minimum education subsidy for fiscal year 1991-92 contained in Part A, section 1.
