HOUSE AMENDMENT "TT" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part L in section 11 by striking out the 2nd sentence (page 135, lines 41 to 48 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in Part X by striking out all of sections 5 to 8 (page 162, lines 38 to 50 and page 163, lines 1 to 32 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in Part X by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of Part NN.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1989, c. 612, is further amended to read:

5. Range 86. The salaries of the following state officials and employees shall-be are within salary range 86:

Director of Labor Standards;

Deputy Chief of the State Police;

Director of State Lotteries;

State Archivist;

44 This amendment proposes net General Fund deappropriations of
46 \$373,373 and eliminates the suspension of merit increases,
48 thereby decreasing the overall amount of General Fund savings in
the bill by \$626,627.

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This amendment reduces the compensation for legislative leadership, removes several education mandate extensions, removes the suspension of merit increases in calendar year 1992 and makes several General Fund appropriations and deappropriations.
