HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "UU" to H.P. 1402,
L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and
Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the
Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change
Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place
the following:

'Amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of section 6.

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 7 under the
caption "**FINANCE, DEPARTMENT OF**" in that part relating to
"**Lottery Operations**" by striking out all of the 2nd line (page 83,
line 43 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Personal Services (40,475)'

Further amend the bill in Part A in section 7 under the
caption "**FINANCE, DEPARTMENT OF**" in that part relating to
"**Lottery Operations**" by striking out all the 3rd to 8th lines
(page 83, lines 45 to 48 and page 84, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) and
inserting in their place the following:

'Provides for the deallocation of funds
through the elimination of one Marketing
Manager position.'

6 This amendment increases total General Fund appropriations
in fiscal year 1991-92 by \$28,134,819 and decreases General Fund
revenue by (\$27,369,148) in fiscal year 1991-92 and (\$6,000,000)
8 in fiscal year 1992-93. This amendment reduces the total General
Fund savings of the bill by \$61,503,967.
