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FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases total General Fund appropriations in fiscal year 1991-92 by \$28,134,819 and decreases General Fund revenue by (\$27,369,148) in fiscal year 1991-92 and (\$6,000,000) in fiscal year 1992-93. This amendment reduces the total General Fund savings of the bill by \$61,503,967.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment incorporates the substance of House Amendment "UU" and makes several technical corrections to effectuate its intent and adds a fiscal note.
