HOUSE AMENDMENT "u" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part GG.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. Calculation and transfer of administrative cost savings.

Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer shall calculate an amount in section 2 of this Part equal to 5% of codes 4000 to 5999 that applies against each General Fund account for all departments and agencies, based on the All Other line category appropriations to those accounts as adjusted pursuant to this Act and allotted within character and object codes 4000 to 5999. The State Budget Officer shall cause the calculated amount to be transferred from each account.

Sec. OO-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.
