HOUSE AMENDMENT "XX" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part M by striking out all of sections 1 to 5 and renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

**PART OO**

**Sec. OO-1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§34,** as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 163, §4, is repealed.

**Sec. OO-2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read  
consecutively.

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**FISCAL NOTE**

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This amendment would gain an estimated \$500,000 in  
additional General Fund revenue in fiscal year 1991-92 by  
removing the sales tax exemption for coin-operated vending  
machine sales. There is also an appropriation of \$500,000 in  
fiscal year 1991-92 to the Department of Human Services,  
resulting in no net fiscal impact to the General Fund.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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In order to increase the funds available for the  
appropriation and allocation for the expenditures of State  
Government, this amendment repeals the sales tax exemption on  
vending machine sales.
