FISCAL NOTE

This amendment would gain an estimated \$500,000 in additional General Fund revenue in fiscal year 1991-92 by removing the sales tax exemption for coin-operated vending machine sales. There is also an appropriation of \$500,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 to the Department of Human Services, resulting in no net fiscal impact to the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

In order to increase the funds available for the 28 appropriation and allocation for the expenditures of State Government, this amendment repeals the sales tax exemption on 30 vending machine sales.
