HOUSE AMENDMENT "X" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part X in section 14 in subsection 6 in the 5th line from the end (page 165, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "December 31, 1992" and inserting in its place the following: 'July 1, 1993'

Further amend the bill in Part X in section 14 in subsection 6 in the 4th line from the end (page 165, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "finds" the following: 'documented, site-specific evidence'

Further amend the bill in Part X in section 14 in subsection 6 in the 3rd line from the end (page 165, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "an" the following: 'extraordinary and'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment extends the closure date from December 31, 1992 to July 1, 1993 for municipal solid waste landfills. This amendment also requires that in order for the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to require an earlier closure for a municipal solid waste landfill, the commissioner must find documented, site-specific evidence that the continued operation of the landfill poses an extraordinary and immediate hazard to the public health or the environment, including without limitation, a threat to a public or private water supply.
