HOUSE AMENDMENT "Z" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill in Part A in section A-1 under the caption "AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND RURAL RESOURCES, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part relating to "Potato Quality Control - Reducing Inspection Costs" by striking out all of the last sentence (page 9, lines 4 to 7 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'Funds for the Maine Bag Program are available for the purpose of reducing inspection costs for the Maine Quality Trademark program. All nontrademark Maine bags are exempt from the mandatory inspection provisions of the Maine bag laws.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces a provision in Part A, section A-1 that governs the operation of the Maine Bag Program.
