SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"


Amend the amendment in section II-1 in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Academy" the following: 'for any such individual whose salary exceeds \$50,000'

Further amend the amendment by striking out the paragraph referring to Part NN (page 2, lines 6 to 10 in amendment)

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the salary adjustment for the University of Maine System, Maine Technical College System and the Maine Maritime Academy applies only to employees with salaries of more than \$50,000. The amendment also eliminates an unnecessary amendment to Part NN.
