SENATE AMENDMENT 'D' to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part NN.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

26 Sec. 00-1. Calculation and transfer. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer shall calculate the amount in section 2 of this Part that 28 applies against each General Fund account for all departments and 30 agencies based on the total appropriations to those accounts, except for the following accounts: General Purpose Aid to Local 32 Schools; Education in the Unorganized Territory; Debt Service -Treasury; Teacher Retirement; Aid to Families with Dependent Children; Aid to Families with Dependent Children - Foster Care; 34 General Assistance; Maine Health Program; Intermediate Care -36 Payments to Providers; Medical Care - Payments to Providers; Bureau of Rehabilitation; and Bureau of Rehabilitation -Vocational Rehabilitation. The State Budget Officer shall cause 38 the calculated amount to be transferred from each account.

Appropriation. 2 The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 4 this Act. 1991-92 6 FINANCE, DEPARTMENT OF 8 10 **Departments and Agencies - Statewide** 12 All Other (\$1,000,000) 14 Provides for the deappropriation of funds by an across-the-board reduction 16 of approximately .3% in 18 fiscal 1991-92, year effective for the last 6 months, except for the 20 General Fund accounts listed in section 1 of this Part. 22 This reduction is in addition 24 to the 1% deappropriation authorized in Public Law 26 1991, chapter 591, Part QQQ.' Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read 28 consecutively. 30 FISCAL NOTE 32 34 This amendment will deappropriate \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 by adding a 3/10 of 1% across-the-board reduction to most General Fund programs. These savings will replace the savings 36 lost through this amendment's striking out of Part NN. Therefore, this amendment will have no net effect on the total 38 General Fund savings realized by the bill. 40 STATEMENT OF FACT 42 44 This amendment removes that part of the bill that places a moratorium on employee merit increases. In order to realize 46 offsetting savings a .3% across-the-board reduction is applied to all accounts except for General Purpose Aid to Local Schools and other specified programs. 48

SENATE AMENDMENT "D' to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985

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The Attorney General has determined that Part NN of the bill would result in unconstitutional interference with existing collective bargaining agreements. This amendment deletes Part NN and deappropriates an amount equal to the savings which would have resulted from enactment of Part NN. In light of the hardship caused to the public by state budget reductions, the deappropriation in this amendment is the result of across-the-board cuts internal to State Government operations.
