SENATE AMENDMENT "^{EE}" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part NN.

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.


FISCAL NOTE

This amendment strikes Part NN that suspended employee merit increases, thereby reducing the total General Fund savings by the bill by (\$1,000,000).

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes that part of the bill that places a moratorium on employee merit increases. The Attorney General has determined that Part NN of the bill would result in unconstitutional interference with existing collective bargaining agreements.
