SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Out-of-state travel suspended. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, out-of-state travel that is funded by the General Fund by any person employed by the State, including employees of the Legislature, the Judicial Department, the Executive Department and independent agencies, is suspended between January 1, 1992 and December 31, 1992. Funds allotted for this purpose may not be expended for any other purpose and must lapse to the General Fund on June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993.'

Further amend the bill by relettering the parts to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will realize some additional General Fund savings through lapsed balances. The amount of savings can not be determined at this time.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment suspends for one year out-of-state travel by state employees that is funded by the General Fund.
