SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment provides a General Fund appropriation of \$47,784 in fiscal year 1991-92 to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner and deappropriates the same amount from the Maine Development Foundation, thereby resulting in no net fiscal impact to the bill.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment restores \$47,784 to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, which was deappropriated from that office in Part A of the bill, and deappropriates the same amount from the Maine Development Foundation.
