SENATE AMENDMENT "L" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, Title 30-A or the deappropriation of funds through the reduction of the fiscal year 1991-92 foundation and minimum education subsidy in Part A, a local school administrative unit may not reduce funding for those schools that have only sufficient funds for the bare necessities that are essential to the operation of a classroom.'


Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment has no affect on the total General Fund deappropriations. It only affects the distribution of the reduction at the local level.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment excludes certain schools operating at minimum levels from receiving a reduction in funds resulting from the reductions to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools.
