HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to SENATE AMENDMENT "N" to H.P. 1402,  
L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and  
Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the  
Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change  
Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the amendment in section K-3 in subsection 2-A in  
paragraph B in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 3, lines 11 and 12 in  
amendment) by striking out the following: "more than 2 of the 3  
licenses issued to replace a state liquor store" and inserting in  
its place the following: 'that owns 2 or more agency liquor  
store licenses statewide'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment could reduce the amount of General Fund  
revenue collected from initial license fees. The amount of the  
reduction can not be determined at this time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment specifies that a person or corporation can  
not be granted an agency liquor store license to replace state  
liquor stores closed in fiscal year 1991-92 if the corporation  
owns 2 or more agency liquor stores statewide.
