SENATE AMENDMENT "*B*" to SENATE AMENDMENT "N" to H.P. 1402,
L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and
Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the
Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change
Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph from the end before
the fiscal note in the 2nd line (page 5, line 2 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "sections 8 to 10 and inserting in
their" and inserting in its place the following: "section 8 and
inserting in its'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the last
paragraph before the fiscal note the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part K in section 9 by striking
out all of the last 2 sentences (page 131, lines 33 to 42 in L.D.)

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the fiscal
note the following:

'Further amend the bill in Part BB in section 2 in
subsection 2 in the first line (page 179, line 6 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "The Bureau" and inserting in its
place the following: 'Effective July 1, 1992, the Bureau'

Further amend the bill in Part BB in section 2 in subsection
2 in the 3rd line (page 179, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after
the following: "all" the following: 'duties and'

Further amend the bill in Part BB in section 2 in subsection
2 by striking out all of the 3rd sentence (page 179, lines 11 to
17 in L.D.)'

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

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment deletes reference to a combined director position for the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations but retains language permitting the combination of the Bureau of the Lottery and the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages, effective July 1, 1992.
