SENATE AMENDMENT "T" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

5 MRSA §1811-A is enacted to read:


§1811-A. Standards

Any person or corporation that participates in the formulation of a request for proposal for a state contract for goods and services is prohibited from bidding or contracting with the State for those goods or services.'

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes standards to ensure integrity in the state bidding process.
