SENATE AMENDMENT "U" to H.P. 1402, L.D. 1985, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993 and to Change Certain Provisions of Law"

Amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART OO

Sec. OO-1. Accounting by state agencies. Every state agency, including every independent state agency, shall file with the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs by January 15, 1992 an accounting of all orders of furniture, machinery and equipment, including computer equipment, delivered to the agency on or after July 1, 1991.

Sec. OO-2. Deappropriation of funds. After its review of the accounting submitted in accordance with section 1, the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs is authorized to report out a bill recommending the deappropriation from the budget of each state agency, including each independent stage agency, the cost of any furniture, machinery or equipment that was delivered to that agency on or after July 1, 1991, except, however, the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs may exempt certain purchases from this deappropriation.'

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read consecutively.

This amendment has no net fiscal impact to the bill.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires every state agency including independent state agencies to file with the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs an accounting of all orders of furniture, machinery and equipment delivered on or after July 1, 1991. After the committee's review of such accountings, the committee is authorized to deappropriate that amount from each agency's budget.
