SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 789, L.D. 1986, Bill, "An Act to Determine the Distribution Method of the Supplemental Reduction to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools for Fiscal Year 1991-92"

Amend the amendment in paragraph F in the 3rd line (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and the minimum subsidy allocation"

Further amend the amendment in paragraph F in subparagraph (1) in last 2 lines (page 1, lines 29 and 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and minimum subsidy"

Further amend the amendment in paragraph F in subparagraph (2) in last line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by inserting after the underlined word "unit" the following: ', except for those units that receive only the minimum subsidy'

Further amend the amendment in paragraph F in the last line (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and minimum subsidy"

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment distributes the reduction in General Purpose Aid for Local Schools over a smaller base but does not affect the savings realized in the budget reduction bill.
