COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 789, L.D. 1986, Bill, "An Act to Determine the Distribution Method of the Supplemental Reduction to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools for Fiscal Year 1991-92"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph F (page 1, lines 20 to 27 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'F. In addition to the reduction specified in paragraph E, for fiscal year 1991-92, the state share of the foundation allocation and the minimum subsidy allocation must be further reduced by an amount based on 50% of each of the following amounts:

(1) An amount calculated as approximately 3.4% of the unit's state share of its foundation allocation and minimum subsidy; and

(2) An amount calculated by multiplying approximately 0.287 mills by the state valuation of the unit.

The amount to be reduced may not exceed the unit's unpaid subsidy for foundation allocation and minimum subsidy.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the method of distributing the supplemental reduction in fiscal year 1991-92 General Purpose Aid for Local Schools with a combination of 2 different approaches. This method was referred to as "option 3" in Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs deliberations.
