SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 789, L.D. 1986, Bill, "An Act to Determine the Distribution Method of the Supplemental Reduction to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools for Fiscal Year 1991-92"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 6 in the 8th line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and the minimum subsidy allocation"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph F in the 3rd line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and the minimum subsidy allocation"


Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph F in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and minimum subsidy"

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment distributes the reduction in General Purpose Aid for Local Schools over a smaller base but does not affect the savings realized in the budget reduction bill.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment revises the distribution of the reduction in General Purpose Aid for Local Schools included in the budget reduction bill for fiscal year 1991-92 by exempting those school administrative units that receive only the minimum subsidy.
