Further amend the amendment in section 4 in paragraph F in the last line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "<u>habitation;</u>" the following: '<u>and</u>'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in paragraph G in 32 the last line (page 2, line 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: "<u>persons; and</u>" and inserting in its place the 34 following: '<u>persons.</u>"
