SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 798, L.D. 1997, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Regarding the Responsibilities of Code Enforcement Officers to Approve Plans or Technical Submissions by Architects"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in paragraph C in the last line (page 2, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "F, G and H; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'F and G;'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the first line (page 2, line 11 in amendment) by striking out the following: "**to H**" and inserting in its place the following: '**and G**'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in paragraph F in the last line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "habitation;" the following: 'and'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in paragraph G in the last line (page 2, line 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: "persons; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'persons.'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by striking out all of paragraph H.


