An Act to Benefit Consumers by Clarifying Directory Advertising for Osteopathic and Allopathic Physicians.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	35-A MRSA §7501-B is enacted to read:
4	§7501-B. Organization of directories for osteopathic and
6	allopathic physicians
8	When a telephone utility or an affiliate of a public utility publishes a directory of customers' names, addresses and
10	telephone numbers or a directory of advertising, the utility or the affiliate shall include all osteopathic and allopathic
12	physicians under one heading entitled "Physicians and Surgeons." Osteopathic physicians may be distinguished in the directory with
14	the letters "D.O." after their names.

20	This bill requires telephone utilities and affiliates that publish directories to list osteopathic physicians and allopathic
22	physicians under the listing of "Physicians and Surgeons."
