#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO

An Act to Clarify the Definition of Resident as it Pertains to Marine Resource Licenses.



	Be it enacted by the Feople of the State of Maine as follows:
2	12 MRSA §6301, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is
4	amended to read:
6	<ol> <li>Resident license. Any individual who has been domiciled in Maine for the 6 months preceding the date of his application</li> </ol>
8	is eligible for a resident license. A corporation shall-be is eligible for a resident license if it has been created and exists
10	under the laws of Maine, and it has existed in Maine during the months preceding the date of application. A firm or partnership
12	shall-be <u>is</u> eligible if all of its officers or partners have been domiciled in Maine for the 6 months preceding the date of
14	application.
16	A person may not be deemed a resident if the person:
18	A. If registered to vote, is not registered in Maine;
20	B. If licensed to drive a motor vehicle, has not made application for a Maine motor vehicle license;
22	C. Owns a motor vehicle or vehicles located within the
24	State and has not registered each such vehicle in Maine; and
26	D. Has not complied with Maine state income tax laws.

The definition of a resident for purposes of issuing a

marine resource harvesting or dealer license is not clearly

stated. This bill adds language to provide clarity.
