SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1410, L.D. 2022, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Laws Related to Credit Cards"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 7 by striking out all of paragraph B (page 1, lines 30 to 32 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'B. The name and location state of the financial institution underwriting the debt must appear ~~with--equal~~ prominence in at least 10-point type on the face of the credit card ~~with-the-name-of-the-seller.~~'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the provisions of the committee amendment to require that identifying information appears in at least 10-point type on the credit card.
