IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO

An Act to Amend the Automobile Assigned Risk Laws of Maine.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 24-A MRSA §2325, sub-§2, ¶C, as amended by PL 1989, c. 797, \$29 and affected by \$\$37 and 38, is repealed and the following 4 enacted in its place: 6 That insurers be required to assume liability at the discretion of the applicant: 8 10 (1) That satisfies the requirements of the financial responsibility laws of this State; and 12 (2) That provides additional increments of liability protection up to \$500,000, \$1,000,000, \$100,000 or 14 \$1,000,000 combined single limit. 16 Notwithstanding subparagraphs (1) and (2), the maximum 18 amount of physical damage coverage for commercial type vehicles must be determined by the superintendent based on 20 the current cost of new vehicles but may not exceed a maximum amount of \$100,000; and 22 STATEMENT OF FACT 24 26 This bill allows consumers who secure motor insurance to purchase limits of liability in excess of the limits

currently authorized.

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
