COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1414, L.D. 2026, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Charter of the Casco Bay Island Transit District"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1981, c. 22, §3-A is enacted to read:

Sec. 3-A. Vacancies; board of directors. The board of directors may fill a vacancy on the board by appointing a member to serve until the next municipal election. Such an appointed member must be a resident or property owner of the same geographic area as the former member whose term the appointed member will serve. If the term of a vacating member extends beyond the date of the next municipal election, a new member must be elected at the next municipal election as provided in section 3 to fill the remainder of that term.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill allows the board of directors of the Casco Bay Island Transit District to fill a vacancy on the board for the remainder of the term of the vacant position. This amendment provides for board appointment to fill a vacancy until the next municipal election. If the term extends beyond that date, a new member must be elected at the municipal election for the remainder of the term.
