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	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
2	Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6	Whereas, the 115th Legislature in 1991 enacted Resolve 1991, chapter 39 to authorize the transfer of property from the
Ū	Department of Marine Resources to the Bigelow Laboratory for
8	Ocean Sciences; and
10	Whereas, the transfer of property is subject to the terms of
12	the resolve, including the responsibility for the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences to absorb all costs incurred in
	operating and maintaining the property; and
14	Whereas, due to the financial inability of the Bigelow
16	Laboratory for Ocean Sciences to operate and maintain the
	property, the authorization given in Resolve 1991, chapter 39
18	should be rescinded as quickly as possible; and
20	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
22	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
24	safety; now, therefore,
26	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
28	Resolve 1991, c. 39 is repealed.
30	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
30	preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

34	STATEMENT OF FACT
36	This bill repeals Resolve 1991, chapter 39, which authorized
	the transfer of property from the Department of Marine Resources
38	to the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences. The Bigelow
40	Laboratory for Ocean Science does not have the money necessary to operate and maintain the property subject to the transfer.
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
