COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1427, L.D. 2039, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Status of Wood Yard Debris"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 38 MRSa §1304, sub-§16 is enacted to read:

16. Wood yard debris. The provisions of this chapter do not apply to soil containing incidental bark or woody material generated during the transport, handling or storage of logs prior to processing. For the purposes of this section, "processing" is defined to include the debarking, chipping and sawing of wood.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment exempts soil that contains incidental bark or woody material generated during the transport, handling or storage of logs prior to processing from regulation as solid waste. The term "processing" is defined to specifically include the debarking, chipping and sawing of wood.
