An Act Concerning Highway Traffic Laws.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 MRSA §1352 is enacted to read:

§1352. Passing lanes

The department shall install and maintain signs directing traffic to keep to the right except to pass on all roads under its jurisdiction that have a passing lane on an inclined grade.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to install and maintain signs directing traffic to keep to the right except to pass on roads that have a passing lane on an inclined grade.
