An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Student Work Hours.



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **26 MRSA §774, sub-§5 is enacted to read:**

6 **5. Application. This section does not apply to a person**
8 **who holds a high school diploma or a high school equivalency**
10 **certificate issued pursuant to Title 20-A, section 257.**

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill clarifies that the restrictions on the work hours
16 of minors do not apply to high school graduates or people who
 have high school equivalency certificates.
