### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO

An Act Concerning the Shared Use of Crop-handling Equipment by Seed Potato Growers.



Вe	it	enacted	by	the	Peop	le of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:

7 MRSA §2103-A, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Shared crop-handling equipment. If seed potatoes from a farm or crop are not certified because of the presence of pathogens, the seed potatoes from any other farm or crop that uses the same crop-handling equipment may not be certified unless sufficient proof exists that the equipment was thoroughly washed and disinfected between farming operations under the supervision of a certified seed potato inspector.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that if 2 or more seed potato growers share crop-handling equipment and the seed potatoes of one grower are not certified because of the presence of pathogens, then the seed potatoes of the other growers may not be certified unless the equipment has been washed and disinfected under the supervision of a certified seed potato inspector.
