IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO

An Act to Allow the Towns of Castle Hill, Chapman and Mapleton to Enter into an Interlocal Agreement.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Interlocal agreement authorized. The Town of Castle Hill, the Town of Chapman and the Town of Mapleton may enter into an interlocal agreement authorizing the respective legislative bodies of those towns to authorize a joint board of municipal officers to establish and set the appropriation for each town for joint expenses only.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill authorizes the Town of Castle Hill, the Town of Chapman and the Town of Mapleton to enter into an interlocal agreement to allow the legislative bodies of those towns to establish a joint board of municipal officers for appropriation purposes.
